



We would like all incoming GKs, FSs, DGKs, Membership Directors, Life Directors, and any officers you feel would learn something from this meeting. If you are an outgoing GK or FS, you are more than welcome to attend and your input would be most helpful to your successors.

Additionally, one of the main topics of discussion with all of our Councils represented will be to discuss the Mobile Ultrasound Vehicle Program that all of our combined District Councils have committed to supporting. Please make sure that you have discussed your 2025~2026 Life plans with your incoming officers prior to the Meeting.

A few items pertaining to the Ultrasound Initiative Program:

- St Peter has scheduled a Dance for October 11, 2025 in their Ballroom that can hold 500 people. They are asking for all councils to help sell tickets to this dance at ALL PARISHES by ALL COUNCILS to try to make that number as close to 500 as possible. All Proceeds (or Profits we will discuss this) from the Dance and Cash Bar will go to this Ultrasound Program.
 - 2. The Restricted KCCF Fund has been set up and a QR code has been attached to this email to be included in any advertising of this program in the future. Donors can go to this site and donate and receive a Tax Deduction.
- 3. Also for private donors, this is a Restricted Fund so that Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs) can be made to it from Traditional IRAs as Charitable Rollovers satisfying a portion of your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) while also offering tax benefits. Below you will find all the information I have for donations into the fund.
- 4. CPCI is currently working for us to develop a Bulletin Ad that can be adjusted based on which Council is using the ad. It will include the QR Code, the Councils participating in the Program, and how the Baby Bottle Drive will work (see the attached Bottle Stuffing PDF I created for St William's Drive this weekend). We ask that each Council include this Customized Ad in your Bulletin when you are going to run the Bottle Drive. Also, if you would like to turn it into a Tipee Sign, It can be used for that as well.
- 5. Also regarding Baby Bottle Drives, please schedule them as far in advance as possible, as we believe it will assist the collections if we can get the existing Mobile Ultrasound Vehicle to the Church the weekend of the Bottle Drive (ideally we can coordinate so that more than one council isn't holding a drive the same weekend). If CPCI can get it to you, they will.

6. Finally, if you are looking to do a drive and don't have your Baby Bottles yet, St Peter's Council is wlling to loan councils their Bottles for the Drive. They have over 1000 Bottles that they are willing to loan (as they did this weekend to St William). The Loan agreement is that however many Bottle you are loaned, you will return that many to them by purchasing as many bottles after the collection weekend (and a few weeks after) so that you are replacing any bottles to St Peter that you do not receive back. I want to thank St Peter's Council for their generosity in this Loan Offer.

I'm sure we will have a lot more to talk about at the meeting on June 21!

Finally, I know that some of you are not going to be in town on June 21. I will set up a Zoom meeting for this Meeting as well. Please make plans to join us by Zoom. I don't have the Premium Zoom Subscription, but will order it for the meeting unless one of your councils has a Premium Zoom Subscription that you can let us use for the meeting. Please let me know if you do.




