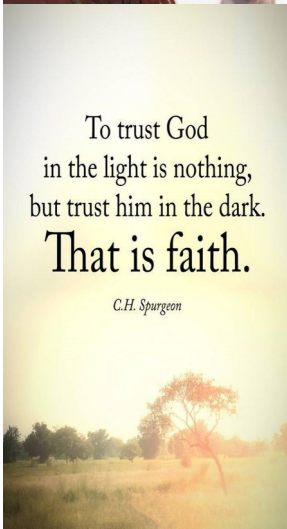

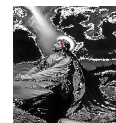

He gathered the men of the parish to form an organization that would help families of the parish who lost the bread winner. From this humble beginning the Knights of Columbus grew to be in all fifty States and worldwide.

So, in 1960 a group men, petition the Knights of Columbus to start a council. We became Santa Maria Council 4999, in Riviera Beach, Florida. These men grew the council over the years and in 1985 they had a new place built in Palm Beach Gardens on Prosperity Farms Road. We do works in the four pillars of, Faith, Family, Life and Community. We give time, talent and money to several local Charities, support our three parish's St. Claire, St. Francis of Assist and St. Patrick's.
