Prayer warriors are needed to keep company with pro-life counselors outside Planned Parenthood southwest reagional headquarters in Sarasota. The counselors are sometimes threatened verbally and physically. If you can spare an hour or whatever time you are able to be present and pray quietly and/or hold a sign nearby, that can help to prevent a volatile situation from escalating. 
