Brother Knights,

Throughout the past several weeks, our Council has had the privilege of celebrating some of the most faithful and joy-filled members of our Church: our children. We honored Brock Shaffer as Florida's State Altar Server of the Year and gathered in appreciation for all the young people who serve so reverently at the altar of God. Seeing their camaraderie and quiet confidence, I was reminded that we are not only witnessing the future of the Church — we are watching the Church *already alive* in them.

In a world increasingly filled with conflict, noise, and tragedy, we look to our children and youth with renewed hope. That hope was on full display recently at the Jubilee Youth Day in Rome, where nearly a million young Catholics came together in faith and witness. What a powerful sign that the fire of Christ's love continues to burn brightly in the hearts of our youngest disciples.

Yet, we know the path is not without sorrow. The recent heartbreaking shooting at the Church of the Annunciation in Minneapolis, which took the lives of two children and wounded many others, shook us all. How do we respond in the face of such senseless evil?

We respond as Knights. We reaffirm our role as protectors, mentors, and witnesses. We commit to loving our youth, praying for them, encouraging their vocations, and surrounding them with the strength of our example. For Jesus Himself did not call us to comfort but to *courage* — and there is no greater courage than to believe in goodness even when the world offers its darkest hour.

So let us take heart. Let us never underestimate the power of a kind word to a child, the importance of presence in their lives, or the influence we hold as Knights of Columbus. Every altar server we thank, every youth we support, every act of faith we pass on — it all matters.

May the Holy Spirit guide us to be men of conviction, men of love, and men of hope. And may we always remember that in the eyes of our children, we are often the first glimpse of Christ they ever see.

The following is the final list of impediments to marriages, the type of law that governs those impediments, and how those impediments may be dispensed.

Impediment	Type of Law	Dispensation by
Abduction	Ecclesiastical	Ceases when the woman can give free consent in a safe place
Crime or Conjuicide	Ecclesiastical	Reserved to the Holy See
Consanguinity	Divine / Ecclesiastical	Never dispensed in the direct line; dispensed in 3 rd degree and 4 th degree of the collateral line by the local ordinary
Affinity	Ecclesiastical	Dispensation from the local ordinary
Public propriety	Ecclesiastical	Dispensation from the local ordinary
Adoption	Ecclesiastical	Dispensation from the local ordinary
