This past month has been very slow, so instead of a report, the FN and myself felt an explanation of the upcoming February/March events is appropriate.

First, let me say to you, my Assembly Brothers about the upcoming news. I, your FC/VM am honored to have received the nomination and support of our Assembly for District Master. Other Assemblies have also given me their nominations and support, and I am grateful and humbled for this outpouring of support and confidence from my Brother Knights. These nominations are a great personal honor, but more importantly they recognize the dedication, sacrifice and commitment of my Brother Knights and CC members. For without you and them, I would not have this opportunity. Wow, that is a mouthful, but what does it mean? Ok, I'll try to keep this short.

We are talking about the Fourth Degree Biennial Meeting coming this March 23. This is mandated by Supreme on even years in March or April. Why two years? The Master serves a two-year term, and he is limited to two terms. Worthy John O'Toole has served two terms, so this biennial is IMPORTANT! I am going to be as brief as I can about the process. February 19 was our most recent business meeting. At this meeting we elected three voting delegates and four alternates, plus voted on any resolutions we wanted to send. For example, one we are talking about is splitting the state into two districts and two Masters (North and South). We get one voting delegate per 100 or any part thereof. The FN is a voting delegate. We just needed to elect his alternate. Only voting delegates are required to go to the meeting, but anyone may attend. This year it is on March 16. They were read and voted on at the meeting and sent to Supreme. Candidates for Master are read, voted on and two or three are submitted to Supreme, who then picks our next Master.

Brothers, with your support and prayers, I pray we can succeed.






