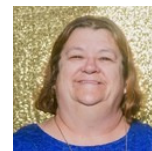
Deacons Report

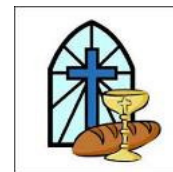
1st Friday Mass Requests

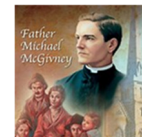
